Notes to Contributors

- a. Copula is a refereed philosophy journal published once in June each year.
- b. Unpublished manuscripts, not more than 15 pages in length, typed double-spaced with an abstract of not more than 150 words may be sent to the Editor.
- Papers should be sent in duplicate. A CD disk containing the paper is also required.
- d. Papers must reach the Editor by 31st March. This deadline of submission is strictly maintained. Papers received after this deadline are considered for the next issue.
- e. E-mail submissions are acceptable, provided that print copies reach the Editor in time.
- f. The name and address of the author should not appear on the paper. A separate page must be used for this purpose.
- g. All papers are subject to blind review after a preliminary selection by the Editorial Board.
- h. Reference within the text: citation should be specified by last name of author and the year of publication with page number (where necessary) as (Ayer, 1946, pp. 106-107).

Reference Style: a list of reference should be included at the end of the article with author's name appearing alphabetically.
