### Stop the Genocide in Gaza

Jahangirnagar University, 07 April 2025

The administration of Jahangirnagar University expresses deep concern over the genocide in Gaza deliberately conducted by the Israeli Defence Forces (IDF). It appears that war crimes have been occurring in Gaza before the international community, and no substantial actions have yet emerged to stop the genocide. The recent acts of brutal violence against innocent civilians in Gaza, particularly the killing of women and children, along with the indiscriminate destruction of buildings and property, are deeply concerning and reprehensible. Such actions violate the fundamental principles of human rights and international law, which demand the protection of non-combatants and the preservation of civilian life, dignity, and property during conflict. The loss of innocent lives, especially those of vulnerable children and women, is a tragedy that cannot be justified under any circumstances.

We urge the international community, particularly, the Govt. of the United States of America and the European Union to put embargo on the responsible officials of the Israeli Govt. and members of the occupying IDF to cease the attacks responsible for genocide in Gaza, and to ensure they comply with international humanitarian law, including the Geneva Conventions, which explicitly prohibit targeting civilians and destroying civilian infrastructure. Every life lost, every family displaced, and every building destroyed represents a deepening crisis that demands immediate and decisive action to end the violence and achieve a lasting and just peace.

Upholding the values of peace, justice, and humanity, Jahangirnagar University stands in solidarity with all those affected by the ongoing violence and calls on the international community, governments, and humanitarian organizations to intervene urgently and ensure accountability for these acts. The protection of human rights must always take precedence over political interests, and breaking the cycle of violence is essential for a peaceful future for all.
